

Junk Removal Checklist

Before You Schedule

Plan ahead to save time and money.

- ☐ Make a list of everything to get rid of
- ☐ Separate reusable, recyclable, or donatable items
- ☐ Check if the local junk removal company accepts those items
- ☐ Estimate how much you have (¼ truck, ½ truck, full truck, or single items)
- ☐ Take a few photos for easier quote requests
- ☐ Research licensed & insured companies in your area
- ☐ Compare at least 2–3 quotes
- ☐ Confirm pickup date and time
- ☐ Ask about accepted payment methods and disposal practices

Sort: Keep, Donate, or Junk

Declutter efficiently before pickup day.

- ☐ Create three piles: Keep / Donate / Junk
- ☐ Set aside items still in good condition for donation
- ☐ Check local thrift stores or shelters for what they accept
- ☐ Consider selling higher-value items online
- ☐ Clearly label junk items for the removal team

 **Pro move:** Many junk removal companies will drop off donations on your behalf — just ask in advance.

Prepare Your Space

Make it easy and safe for the crew to work.

- ☐ Clear walkways, stairs, and doorways
- ☐ Move cars out of the driveway
- ☐ Keep pets and kids safely out of the way
- ☐ Protect floors or carpets if needed

- ☐ Disconnect any appliances to be removed
- ☐ Group items together in one accessible area
- ☐ Double-check that nothing valuable is mixed in

💡 **Quick check:** Can a large item (like a sofa or fridge) fit through your doorway? Measure in advance to avoid delays.

On Pickup Day

Stay organized and informed.

- ☐ Review the final price before loading begins
- ☐ Move cars out of the driveway
- ☐ Confirm what will be recycled or donated
- ☐ Ask for a receipt or invoice for records
- ☐ Snap a quick photo of the cleared space
- ☐ Leave an honest review to help others find reliable services

💡 **Helpful reminder:** Prices are often based on truck space used — consolidating items tightly can lower the cost.

After the Job

Wrap up and keep the space clutter-free.

- ☐ Sweep, vacuum, or wipe down the cleared area
- ☐ Donate or recycle anything left behind
- ☐ Schedule a hazardous waste drop-off if needed
- ☐ Set a reminder for the next seasonal cleanup
